| 1648, East Sussex | Saint George | 4.5 | APRIL BREW. Medium brown in colour, sweet and full flavoured with a well rounded aroma. A traditional English Ale. |
| Acorn, South Yorkshire | Sovereign | 4.4 | A ruby coloured premium bitter, with well balanced flavours of roast malt, fruit and hops. |
| Acorn, South Yorkshire | St. George's Best | 4.6 | APRIL BREW. A dark ruby coloured beer brewed for St George's Day. |
| Ascot Ales, Surrey | Royal IPA | 4.6 | APRIL BREW. Royal Wedding special ale from Ascot. Light copper coloured IPA with straw notes. Brewed with English Sovereign hops. |
| Brentwood, Essex | Hot XXX Buns | 3.9 | APRIL BREW. A fruity, spiced brown ale with citrus hop notes. |
| Brentwood, Essex | Big Bunny | 4.4 | APRIL BREW. A crisp golden ale with plenty of bounce from the Beata hops. |
| Burton Bridge, Burton On Trent | Sovereign Gold | 4.0 | A straw coloured bitter with a citrusy aroma and a lingering bitterness. |
| Busheys, Isle of Man | Castletown Bitter | 3.5 | A light, golden beer full of floral and citrus hints. A wonderfully refreshing and truly fantastic session beer! |
| Coach House, Warrington | Cromwell's | 4.0 | A well balanced amber coloured beer with a smooth clean hoppy finish. Named after Oliver Cromwell, whose statue stands in Warrington Town. |
| Corvedale, Shropshire | Katie's Pride | 4.3 | A dark mild ale with a sweet aftertaste. |
| Cottage, Somerset | Golden Arrow | 4.5 | A light golden colour with a distinctive floral hop flavour and aroma. A refreshing, thirst quenching pint. |
| Downton, Wiltshire | Downton Abbey Ale | 4.2 | A blend of traditional smoked and amber malts provide a toasted, biscuity flavour to this well crafted amber best bitter. Fuggles and German Mittlefruh hops add a delicate floral aroma and a clean hoppy bitterness. |
| Fuzzy Duck, Lancashire | Cunning Stunt | 4.3 | Golden coloured single-hop beer brewed with American Willamette hops. Wonderful blackcurrant and herb aroma. |
| Goose Eye, West Yorkshire | Bronte Bitter | 4.0 | An amber bitter with a faint fruity, hoppy aroma. |
| Hadrian & Border Newcastle upon Tyne | New Secret Kingdom | 4.3 | Dark, rich and full-bodied with a slightly roasted malty palate and a pleasant bitterness in the finish. |
| Hambleton, North Yorkshire | Silly Filly | 4.0 | APRIL BREW. |
| Holden's, West Midlands | April Showers | 4.3 | Sparkling primrose in colour with a delicate hoppy aroma, this medium bodied beer has an underlying gentle malty sweetness and muted cereal notes, which develops into a restorative bitter finish. A totally revitalizing experience! |
| Hopback, Wiltshire | George's Favourite Bitter | 3.5 | APRIL BREW. Golden coloured with a light, clean, moreish and tasty quality. Hoppy aroma and taste leading to a good, dry finish. |
| Houston, Renfrewshire | Hunny Bunny | 4.1 | APRIL BREW. This honey coloured ale is smooth and easy drinking with a fresh hop aroma. A fusion of malt, hops and honey produce this lipsmackingly good beer. |
| JW Lees, Manchester | Coronation Street | 4.2 | Smooth & full bodied. This crisp, moreish, premium ale has a rich auburn glow and a hoppy, malty smell. |
| Loddon, Oxfordshire | Gorgeous George | 4.3 | APRIL BREW. The finest English barley malt combines with our two oldest varieties of English hops: Fuggles and Goldings, to thrill your taste buds and remind you of a true, traditional, old fashioned bitter. |

| Northumberland, Bedlington | Bucking Fastard | 4.0 | A refreshing floral hoppy session ale that has a surprising kick. |
| Oakleaf, Hampshire | Pompey Royal | 4.5 | Brewed to a traditional recipe, Pompey Royal is a sweet and malty ale with a delicate hop finish. |
| Ossett, West Yorkshire | Silver King | 4.3 | A lager style beer with a crisp, dry flavour and citrus fruity aroma. |
| Palmers, Dorset | Tally Ho | 5.5 | A strong, nutty, full strength dark beer that has built a cult following since it was first brewed for bottles in 1949. Oaky and roasted flavour, with a deep and distinctive taste. |
| Phoenix, Lancashire | St. George's Flag | 4.3 | Pale golden colour, full rounded palate, the depth of bitterness gives way to a hint of sweetness. |
| Potbelly, Northamptonshire | Made in England | 4.4 | APRIL BREW. A medium English ale, full of flavour with moderate bitterness. |
| Quantock, Somerset | Wills Neck | 4.3 | A golden ale produced from the finest Maris Otter malt and English whole hop cones. The majority of the hops are added late in the boil to give more hop flavour and aroma, balancing the full malty flavour in the beer. |
| Rudgate, York | Battleaxe | 4.2 | A robust premium bitter with an initial sweetness and gentle bitterness, leading to a complex fruity flavour. |
| Salopian, Shropshire | Golden Thread | 5.0 | A bright gold ale, using wheat and lager malt and flavoured with First Gold hops. |
| Springhead, Nottinghamshire | Charlie's Angel | 4.5 | Light, golden, fruity & refreshing ale. |
| St Georges, Worcestershire | England's Finest | 4.0 | APRIL BREW. Ruby red in colour spicy taste to start and a lasting bitter taste to finish. |
| Strathaven, Lanarkshire | Duchess Anne | 3.9 | SPRING SPECIAL. A refreshing crisp ale using a blend of wheat and lager malts flavoured with fresh meadowsweet. |
| Three Castles, Wiltshire | Saxon Archer | 4.0 | A balanced, easy drinking session ale with a wonderful aroma and a hoppy, fruity palate. |
| Titanic, Burslem on Trent | English Glory | 4.5 | APRIL BREW. This rose red beer, brewed using only English ingredients, has the poise and balance, strength and guile to defeat any dragon's thirst. |
| Tring, Hertfordshire | Royal Poacher | 4.1 | SPRING SPECIAL. Burnished gold, medium bodied beer hopped with First Gold. The result is an extremely drinkable bitter with hoppy notes yet fruity with citrus flavours. |
| Vale, Buckinghamshire | Edgar's Golden Ale | 4.3 | English Golden ale, infused with traditional English hops, floral hoppy aromas and a warm bitterness with soft pineapple and zesty Lemon flavours. |
| Westerham, Kent | British Bulldog Best Bitter | 4.3 | APRIL BREW. A rich, full bodied best bitter in the traditional Kent style. Finest Maris Otter pale ale malt and Crystal malt for colour and richness. Hopped with local Northdown and Whitbread Golding hops. |
| Williams Brothers Clackmannanshire | Williams Gold | 3.9 | A refreshing and full bodied sparkling golden ale, brewed using a blend of seven malts. Undertones of vanilla and fruit are offset by the citrus aroma of fresh hops, suggesting grapefruit and orange. |
| Williams Brothers Clackmannanshire | Williams Red | 4.5 | A rich ruby malt ale, medium dry with hints of toffee and banana. Balanced with fresh spicy hops to give a zesty, peppery backdrop. Red is a warming full flavoured beer to be savoured. |
| Williams Brothers Clackmannanshire | Williams 80/- | 4.2 | Dark in colour with the emphasis on the malt characteristics and a subtle late hopping and orange zest infusion. |
| Windsor & Eton Berkshire | Windsor Knot | 4.0 | APRIL BREW. Royal Wedding special ale from Windsor & Eton. Refreshing golden ale with a fruity aroma. Brewed with English Sovereign hops & New Zealand Nelson's Sauvignon hops. |
| Windsor & Eton Berkshire | Guardsman | 4.2 | The first new ale brewed in Windsor for 80 years was launched on St. George's Day 2010. Lovely copper coloured session beer with a tangy taste, smoothed by oak conditioning and a fresh hop finish. |
| Windsor & Eton Berkshire | Knight of the Garter | 3.8 | Straw coloured, easy-drinking session ale. |
