

# THE JUNCTION TAVERN

## White 175ml / 250ml / Btl

- 1) **Airén, Finca Nova, Spain** 5.1 / 7.1 / 21  
*A refreshing white, with a delicate aroma of green apple, joined by subtle lemon and pear on the palate.*
- 2) **Organic Verdejo, Dominio de la Fuente, Spain** 5.8 / 8.2 / 24  
*A crisp, aromatic white wine, showing great purity of aromas. Intense fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper.*
- 3) **Sauvignon Blanc, Jean de la Roche, France** 5.8 / 8.2 / 24  
*Classy, crisp Sauvignon Blanc. Passion fruit, freshly cut grass and elderflower entwined with refreshing acidity.*
- 4) **Chardonnay, Five Foot Track, Australia** 6.2 / 8.75 / 26  
*Soft and well rounded, beautiful characteristics of cooked apple and vanilla.*
- 5) **Colombard, Chemin des Dames, France** 6.8 / 9.5 / 28  
*A medium dry wine. Ripe honeydew melon, nectarine and pineapple, with an attractive sweetness.*
- 6) **Picpoul de Pinet, L'abeille, France** 6.8 / 9.5 / 28  
*Youthful, refreshing white wine, full of lively lemon fruit and lime zest flavours.*
- 7) **Sauvignon Blanc, Fathoms, Marlborough, New Zealand** 29.5  
*Springs from the glass, offering plumes of gooseberry, mango and elderflower.*
- 8) **Gavi, Valle Berta, Italy** 31.5  
*Subtle traces of honeysuckle with characteristic aromas of lime zest and minerality. Clean, refreshing finish.*
- 9) **Riesling, Autumn, Penfolds, Australia** 35  
*An ever-evolving sensorial experience. Sweet poached pear and lemon curd, balanced by green apple purity.*
- 10) **Sancerre, Berthier Blanc, Loire** 45  
*Aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry leap from the glass, with hints of lime, chalk and flint.*

## Champagne & Sparkling 125ml / Btl

- 21) **Prosecco, Corte Alta, Italy** 7.5 / 35  
*Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and elegant zest.*
- 22) **Champagne, Paul Drouet Brut** 60  
*Apple and brioche lead the way in this medium bodied, fruity and classically biscuity style of Champagne.*

## Red 175ml / 250ml / Btl

- 11) **Tempranillo, Finca Nova, Spain** 5.1 / 7.1 / 21  
*Subtle notes of red cherry, raspberry and redcurrant dominate this medium bodied, soft and juicy red.*
- 12) **Merlot, Bresco, Italy** 5.65 / 8 / 23  
*Super smooth wine with a soft and plummy texture and hints of vanilla.*
- 13) **Pinot Noir, Three Realms, Romania** 6.2 / 8.75 / 26  
*All the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy notes you'd expect from a fantastic Pinot Noir*
- 14) **Malbec, Carelli 34, Mendoza** 6.55 / 9.1 / 27  
*Plum and Cranberry perfume with good spice. Soft but plentiful tannins work well with the acidity and depth of fruit.*
- 15) **Carignan, Baron de Baussac, France** 6.8 / 9.5 / 28  
*Crammed with concentrated and voluptuous black cherry fruit. Subtle vanilla providing a polished finish.*
- 16) **Côtes du Rhône, Remy Febras, France** 28.5  
*This garrigue scented wine has succulent notes of red and black berry fruits with warming hints of black pepper.*
- 17) **Tempranillo, Marques de Postulado, Rioja** 29  
*A harmonious balance between sweet spice and black fruits of the forrest. A smooth velvety Rioja*
- 18) **Beaujolais Village, Sabot, Beaujolais** 30  
*Packed with juicy strawberry, raspberry and cherry fruit flavours. Bright and youthful with a fresh finish. Available chilled on request.*
- 19) **Esprit de Lussac, Bordeaux, St Emilion** 34  
*Juicy black fruit on the nose and cranberry nuances on the palate, tied together with a smoky sandalwood character*
- 20) **Malbec, Rutini, Argentina** 40  
*A deep and richly flavoured wine. Forest fruit, coca and liquorice notes come together in a voluptuous, long finish.*

## Rosé 175ml / 250ml / Btl

- 23) **Two Birds One Stone, France** 5.65 / 8 / 23  
*A fantastic example of an off-dry, easy drinking wine, full of summer fruit flavours and a hint of spice and sweetness.*
- 24) **Chateau St Hippolyte, Provence** 6.8 / 9.5 / 28  
*Elegant aromas of roses and red fruits, Full bodied and fresh with a long finish. Classic Provence style.*
